On Board Math Prep is a FREE, individualized program offered before the start of a semester to improve math skills.

By reviewing math concepts and procedures, we are hoping students will gain the skills and confidence necessary to succeed in their math class.

Any student accepted to CVCC who has not taken a CVCC math course in the last three years can participate. It is intended for students placing into MTH 098.

Participants attend an orientation session and then set their own schedule. Sessions are available both day and night beginning after midterm. See the schedule.

**WHERE

held?**

Orientation takes place in the Math Tutoring Center on the third floor of Owen Hall (LRC) but students can then work from any computer with internet access.

# On Board Math Prep

MyMathTest, a web-based tool, is used to individualize instruction. During an Orientation Session, participants are given FREE access to MyMathTest and instructed on its use.
